I don't think the donut or doughnut craze is going away anytime soon. Us Chicagoans LOVE our donuts, so use this checklist to help you plan your own fun Chicago donut tour throughout Chicago neighborhoods

DOUGHNUT VAULT <http://doughnutvault.com>

- Start at this location first because it gets busy on the weekends, there's usually a line and they sell out fast.
- Order any of the old fashioned doughnuts.

DO-RITE DONUTS <http://doritedonuts.com>

- It's about a 20 minute walk from Doughnut Vault to Do-Rite Donuts
- Order The Sweet Heat which is a fried chicken sandwich on a glazed donut or the candied maple bacon
- Order the chocolate with white chocolate sprinkles, the red velvet, and the vanilla bean glazed.

FIRECAKES <http://firecakesdonuts.com>

- You can easily walk from Glazed and Infused to Firecakes, it will take you about 20 minutes.
- Order the honey glazed, chocolate hazelnut long john, classic jelly, or the peanut butter cup.
- Or you can try the ice cream sandwich donut

STAN'S DONUTS & COFFEE <http://www.stansdonutschicago.com>

- After Firecakes you can walk 10 minutes to Stan's.
- Order the buttermilk bar, blueberry bismark or the blueberry fritter, biscoff or the nutella pocket

DINKEL'S BAKERY <http://www.dinkels.com/sweet>

- You can get on the Brown Line at Diversey and get off at the Paulina stop and the bakery is about a block away.
- Order the chocolate covered bismark donut.

BOMBOBAR <http://bombobar.com>

- Brown Line and switch to the Green Line at Clark and Lake, then get off the Green Line at Morgan and walk a few blocks over to BomboBar. Or you can Uber...
 - Get a box of Bomboloni's to share.
