Locations of all 150 Central Kalos Pokemon in Pokemon X and Y. Contains Story Spoilers.
Contains the most common/easiest locations or requirements for obtaining each available Pokemon. Pokemon may be found in locations not listed. Information pulled multiple sources, including "The Official Kalos Region Pokedex & Postgame Adventure Guide" and Serebii.net

- #001 Chespin - Starter Pokemon, Receive from Tierno in Aquacorde Town at the start of the game. Also may receive from Shauna in Vaniville Town after entering Hall of Fame and chose Fennekin initially.
- #002 Quilladin - Evolve from Chespin (level 16)
- #003 Chestnaught - Evolve from Quilladin (level 36)
- #004 Fennekin - Starter Pokemon, Receive from Tierno in Aquacorde Town at the start of the game. Also may receive from Shauna in Vaniville Town after entering Hall of Fame and chose Froakie initially.
- #005 Braixen - Evolve from Fennekin (level 16)
- #006 Delphox - Evolve from Braixen (level 36)
- #007 Froakie - Starter Pokemon, Receive from Tierno in Aquacorde Town at the start of the game. Also may receive from Shauna in Vaniville Town after entering Hall of Fame and chose Chespin initially.
- #008 Frogadier - Evolve from Froakie (level 16)
- #009 Greninja - Evolve from Frogadier (level 36)
- #010 Bunnelby - Route 2 (grass), Route 3 (grass), Route 5 (grass, purple flowers)
- #011 Diggersby - Evolve from Bunnelby (level 20), Route 22 (yellow flowers)
- #012 Zigzagoon - Route 2 (grass)
- #013 Linoone - Evolve from Zigzagoon (level 20)
- #014 Fletchling - Route 2 (grass), Route 3 (grass), Santalune Forest (grass)
- #015 Fletchinder - Evolve from Fletchling (level 17)
- #016 Talonflame - Evolve from Fletchinder (level 35)
- #017 Pidgy - Route 2 (grass), Route 3 (grass)
- #018 Pidgeotto - Evolve from Pidgy (level 18)
- #019 Pidgeot - Evolve from Pidgeotto (level 36)
- #020 Scatterbug - Route 2 (grass), Santalune Forest (grass)
- #021 Spewpa - Evolve from Scatterbug (level 9), Route 7 (shaking area)
- #022 Vivillon - Evolve from Spewpa (level 12)
 - Note: Vivillon has 20 different forms, 18 of which are based on the geographic location entered into the 3DS when the game was started. A map may be located here: <https://bit.ly/3efLEWC>
 - It is not possible to change the Vivillon Form mid-playthrough. Other forms are only obtainable via trading with

other players or restarting a secondary X/Y game with the 3DS changed to a different region.

- Not all forms are available depending on where the 3DS system was originally sold. For example, American players cannot access the Tundra, Garden, Monsoon, Meadow, River, or Elegant Vivillons
- The Fancy Pattern and Poke Ball Pattern Vivillons were event-only distributions and are not obtainable during standard gameplay.
- #023 Caterpie - Route 2 (grass, Y Version only), Santalune Forest (grass, both versions)
- #024 Metapod - Evolve from Caterpie (level 7), Santalune Forest (grass, Y Version only)
- #025 Butterfree - Evolve from Metapod (level 10)
- #026 Weedle - Route 2 (grass, X Version only), Santalune Forest (grass, both versions)
- #027 Kakuna - Evolve from Weedle (level 7), Santalune Forest (grass, X Version only)
- #028 Beedrill - Evolve from Kakuna (level 10)
- #029 Pansage - Santalune Forest (grass)
- #030 Simisage - Evolve from Pansage (Leaf Stone)
- #031 Pansear - Santalune Forest (grass)
- #032 Simisear - Evolve from Pansear (Fire Stone)
- #033 Panpour - Santalune Forest (grass)
- #034 Simipour - Evolve from Panpour (Water Stone)
- #035 Pichu - Breed Pikachu or Raichu with Ditto then hatch the resulting egg
- #036 Pikachu - Santalune Forest (grass), Route 3 (grass), Evolve from Pichu (level up after achieving high friendship)
- #037 Raichu - Evolve from Pikachu (Thunderstone)
- #038 Bidoof - Route 3 (grass), Route 22 (grass)
- #039 Bibarel - Evolve from Bidoof (level 15), Route 22 (yellow flowers)
- #040 Dunsparce - Route 3 (grass), Route 22 (grass, yellow flowers)
- #041 Azurill - Route 3 (grass), Route 22 (grass)
- #042 Marill - Evolve from Azurill (level up after achieving high friendship), Route 3 (surfing)
- #043 Azumarill - Evolve from Marill (level 18), Route 22 (surfing, yellow flowers)
- #044 Burmy - Route 3 (tall grass) -- NOTE: Has 3 different forms depending on the environment where it last battled, so catching three female Burmy and one male Burmy is recommended.
 - Trash Cloak - Battle inside of a building
 - Sandy Cloak - Battle in caves or on sand
 - Plant Cloak - Battle in grass
- #045 Wormadam - Evolve from Burmy (level 20, female only) -- NOTE: Has 3 different forms, depending on the Cloak Burmy had at the time of evolution. This does result in different typings.
 - Trash Cloak - Bug/Steel

- Sandy Cloak - Bug/Ground
- Plant Cloak - Bug/Grass
- #046 Mothim - Evolve from Burmy (level 20, male only, Cloak does not matter)
- #047 Surkit - Breed Masquerain with Ditto and hatch the resulting egg
- #048 Masquerain - Route 3 (surfing)
- #049 Magikarp - Route 3 (old rod), Route 22 (old rod), Parfum Palace (old rod)
- #050 Gyarados - Evolve from Magikarp (level 20), Route 3 (super rod), Route 22 (super rod)
 - Mega Evolution - Gyaradosite - Obtain in Courlway Town between 8:00PM and 8:59PM after obtaining the Mega Ring from Professor Sycamore
- #051 Corphish - Route 3 (good rod), Parfum Palace (good rod)
- #052 Crawdaunt - Evolve from Cophish (level 30), Route 3 (super rod), Parfum Palace (super rod)
- #053 Goldeen - Route 3 (good rod), Route 22 (good rod), Parfum Palace (good rod)
- #054 Seaking - Evolve from Goldeen (level 33), Route 3 (super rod), Route 22 (super rod)
- #055 Carvanha - Route 22 (good rod)
- #056 Sharpedo - Evolve from Carvanha (level 30), Route 22 (super rod)
- #057 Litleo - Route 22 (grass, yellow flowers)
- #058 Pyroar - Evolve from Litleo (level 35)
 - Note: Male Pyroar and female Pyroar have different, unique sprites
- #059 Psyduck - Route 22 (grass, yellow flowers, surfing), Route 7 (horde battle)
- #060 Golduck - Evolve from Psyduck (level 33)
- #061 Farfetch'd - Route 22 (grass, yellow flowers)
- #062 Riolu - Route 22 (grass, yellow flowers)
- #063 Lucario - Evolve from Riolu (level up with high friendship between 4:00AM and 7:59PM), Receive from Korrina in the Tower of Mastery in Shalour City
 - Mega Evolution - Lucarionite - The Lucario received from Korrina will be holding this
- #064 Ralts - Route 4 (red flowers, yellow flowers) -- make sure to catch at least one male Ralts
- #065 Kirlia - Evolve from Ralts (level 20)
- #066 Gardevoir - Evolve from Kirlia (level 30, can be male or female)
 - Mega Evolution - Gardevoirite - The Ralts traded by Diantha at Cafe Soleil on South Boulevard in Lumoise City after entering the Hall of Fame is holding it. She accepts any Pokemon in the trade.
- #067 Gallade - Evolve from Kirlia (Dawn Stone, male only)
- #068 Flabebe - Route 4 (red flowers, yellow flowers), Route 7 (grass, purple flowers, yellow flowers). Note: Has 5 forms based on the color of flower where it was caught. The form cannot be changed.
 - Red Flower - Red Flowers on Route 4

- Yellow Flower - Yellow Flowers on Route 4 or Route 7
- Orange Flower - Yellow or Red Flowers on Route 4
- Blue Flower - Purple Flowers on Route 7
- White Flower - Yellow or Red Flowers on Route 4
- #069 Floette - Evolve from Flabebe (level 19) Note: Has 5 (+1) forms based on the color of Flabebe it evolved from. The form cannot be changed.
 - Red Flower
 - Yellow Flower
 - Orange Flower
 - Blue Flower
 - White Flower
 - Eternal Flower - Event Pokemon not currently obtainable during standard gameplay. It cannot breed or evolve.
- #070 Florges - Evolve from Floette (Shiny Stone) Note: Has 5 forms based on the color of Floette if evolved from. The form cannot be changed.
 - Red Flower
 - Yellow Flower
 - Orange Flower
 - Blue Flower
 - White Flower
- #071 Budew - Route 4 (red flowers, yellow flowers)
- #072 Roselia - Evolve from Budew (level up after achieving high friendship between 4:00AM and 7:59PM), Route 7 (purple flowers, yellow flowers, grass, horde battle)
- #073 Roserade - Evolve from Roselia (Shiny Stone)
- #074 Ledyba - Route 4 (yellow flowers, red flowers)
- #075 Ledian - Evolve from Ledyba (level 18)
- #076 Combee - Route 4 (yellow flowers, red flowers) - Must catch a female Combee.
- #077 Vespiquen - Evolve from Combee (level 21, female only)
- #078 Skitty - Route 4 (yellow flowers, red flowers)
- #079 Delcatty - Evolve from Skitty (Moon Stone)
- #080 Bulbasaur - Receive from Professor Sycamore in Lumiose City (only one of the three Kanto starters)
- #081 Ivysaur - Evolve from Bulbasaur (level 16)
- #082 Venusaur - Evolve from Ivysaur (level 32)
 - Mega Evolution - Venusaurite - Given by Professor Sycamore if chose Bulbasaur. Can also be purchased at the Stone Emporium in Lumiose City.

- #083 Charmander - Receive from Professor Sycamore in Lumiose City (only one of the three Kanto starters)
- #084 Charmeleon - Evolve from Charmander (level 16)
- #085 Charizard - Evolve from Charmeleon (level 36)
 - Mega Evolution - Charizardite X - X VERSION EXCLUSIVE - Given by Professor Sycamore if chose Charmander. Can also be purchased at the Stone Emporium in Lumiose City.
 - Mega Evolution - Charizardite Y - Y VERSION EXCLUSIVE - Given by Professor Sycamore if chose Charmander. Can also be purchased at the Stone Emporium in Lumiose City.
- #086 Squirtle - Receive from Professor Sycamore in Lumiose City (only one of the three Kanto starters)
- #087 Wartortle - Evolve from Squirtle (level 16)
- #088 Blastoise - Evolve from Wartortle (level 36)
 - Mega Evolution - Blastoisinite - Given by Professor Sycamore if chose Squirtle. Can also be purchased at the Stone Emporium in Lumiose City
- #089 Skiddo - Route 5 (grass, purple flowers)
- #090 Gogoat - Evolve from Skiddo (level 32)
- #091 Pancham - Route 5 (grass, purple flowers)
- #092 Pangoro - Evolve from Pancham (level 32 while having a Dark-type Pokemon in the party)
- #093 Furfrou - Route 5 (grass, purple flowers)
 - Note: Furfrou has 8 "trims" in addition to its "natural form." Its appearance can be altered by grooming it in Lumiose City's Friseur Furfrou store. It will revert to natural after 5 days.
- #094 Dodou - Route 5 (grass, purple flowers)
- #095 Dodrio - Evolve from Doduo (level 31)
- #096 Plusle - X VERSION SEMI-EXCLUSIVE - X Version: Route 5 (grass, purple flowers); Both Versions: Route 5 (horde battle)
- #097 Minun - Y VERSION SEMI-EXCLUSIVE - Y Version: Route 5 (grass,purple flowers); Both Versions: Route 5 (horde battle)
- #098 Gulpin - Route 5 (grass, purple flowers, horde battle)
- #099 Swalot - Evolve from Gulpin (level 26)
- #100 Scraggy - Route 5 (horde battle)
- #101 Scrafty - Evolve from Scraggy (level 39)
- #102 Abra - Route 5 (grass, purple flowers)
- #103 Kadabra - Evolve from Abra (level 16)
- #104 Alakazam - Evolve from Kadabra (link-trade with another player)
 - Mega Evolution - Alakazite - Obtain in Reflection Cave between 8:00PM and 8:59PM after obtaining the Mega Ring from Professor Sycamore
- #105 Oddish - Route 6 (very tall grass)

- #106 Gloom - Evolve from Oddish (level 21)
- #107 Vileplume - Evolve from Gloom (Leaf Stone)
- #108 Bellossom - Evolve from Gloom (Sun Stone)
- #109 Sentret - Route 6 (very tall grass)
- #110 Furret - Evolve from Sentret (level 15)
- #111 Nincada - Route 6 (very tall grass)
- #112 Ninjask - Evolve from Nincada (level 20)
- #113 Shedinja - Evolve Nincada to Ninjask (level 20, must have an additional inventory space and at least one Pokeball when evolution happens)
- #114 Espurr - Route 6 (very tall grass) -- catch one of each gender
- #115 Meowstic - Evolve from Espurr (level 25)
 - Note: Meowstic has both a male "Blue Form" and a female "White Form" which are unique sprites.
- #116 Kecleon - Route 6 (very tall grass)
- #117 Honededge - Route 6 (very tall grass)
- #118 Doublade - Evolve from Honededge (level 35)
- #119 Aegislash - Evolve from Doublade (Dusk Stone)
 - Note: Aegislash has two forms depending on the move it uses. Blade Forme comes from using a physical or special move. Shield Forme comes from using the move King's Shield.
- #120 Venipede - Route 6 (jumps out of shaking bush)
- #121 Whirlipede - Evolve from Venipede (level 22)
- #122 Scolipede - Evolve from Whirlipede (level 30)
- #123 Audino - Route 6 (jumps out of shaking bush)
- #124 Smeargle - Route 7 (grass, purple flowers, yellow flowers)
- #125 Croagunk - Route 7 (grass, purple flowers, yellow flowers)
- #126 Toxicroak - Evolve from Croagunk (level 37)
- #127 Ducklett - Route 7 (grass, purple flowers, yellow flowers)
- #128 Swanna - Evolve from Ducklett (level 35)
- #129 Spritzee - Y VERSION EXCLUSIVE - Route 7 (grass, purple flowers, yellow flowers)
- #130 Aromatisse - Evolve from Spritzee (link-trade with another player while holding a Satchet)
- #131 Swirlix - X VERSION EXCLUSIVE - Route 7 (grass, purple flowers, yellow flowers)
- #132 Slurpuff - Evolve from Swirlix (link-trade with another player while holding a Whipped Dream)
- #133 Volbeat - Route 7 (grass, purple flowers, yellow flowers)
- #134 Illumise - Route 7 (grass, purple flowers, yellow flowers)

- #135 Hoppip - Route 7 (horde battle)
- #136 Skiploom - Evolve from Hoppip (level 18)
- #137 Jumpluff - Evolve from Skiploom (level 27)
- #138 Munchlax - Breed Snorlax holding a Full Incense with Ditto and hatch the resulting egg
- #139 Snorlax - Static Encounter on Route 7 using the Poke Flute
- #140 Whismur - Connecting Cave (walking, horde battle)
- #141 Loudred - Evolve from Whismur (level 20)
- #142 Exploud - Evolve from Loudred (level 40)
- #143 Meditite - Connecting Cave (walking)
- #144 Medicham - Evolve from Meditite (level 37)
 - Mega Evolution - Medichamite - Obtain in Laverre City between 8:00PM and 8:59PM after obtaining the Mega Ring from Professor Sycamore
- #145 Zubat - Connecting Cave (walking, horde battle)
- #146 Golbat - Evolve from Zubat (level 22)
- #147 Crobat - Evolve from Crobat (level up after achieving high friendship)
- #148 Axew - Connecting Cave (walking, horde battle)
- #149 Fraxure - Evolve from Axew (level 38)
